## About SUEN

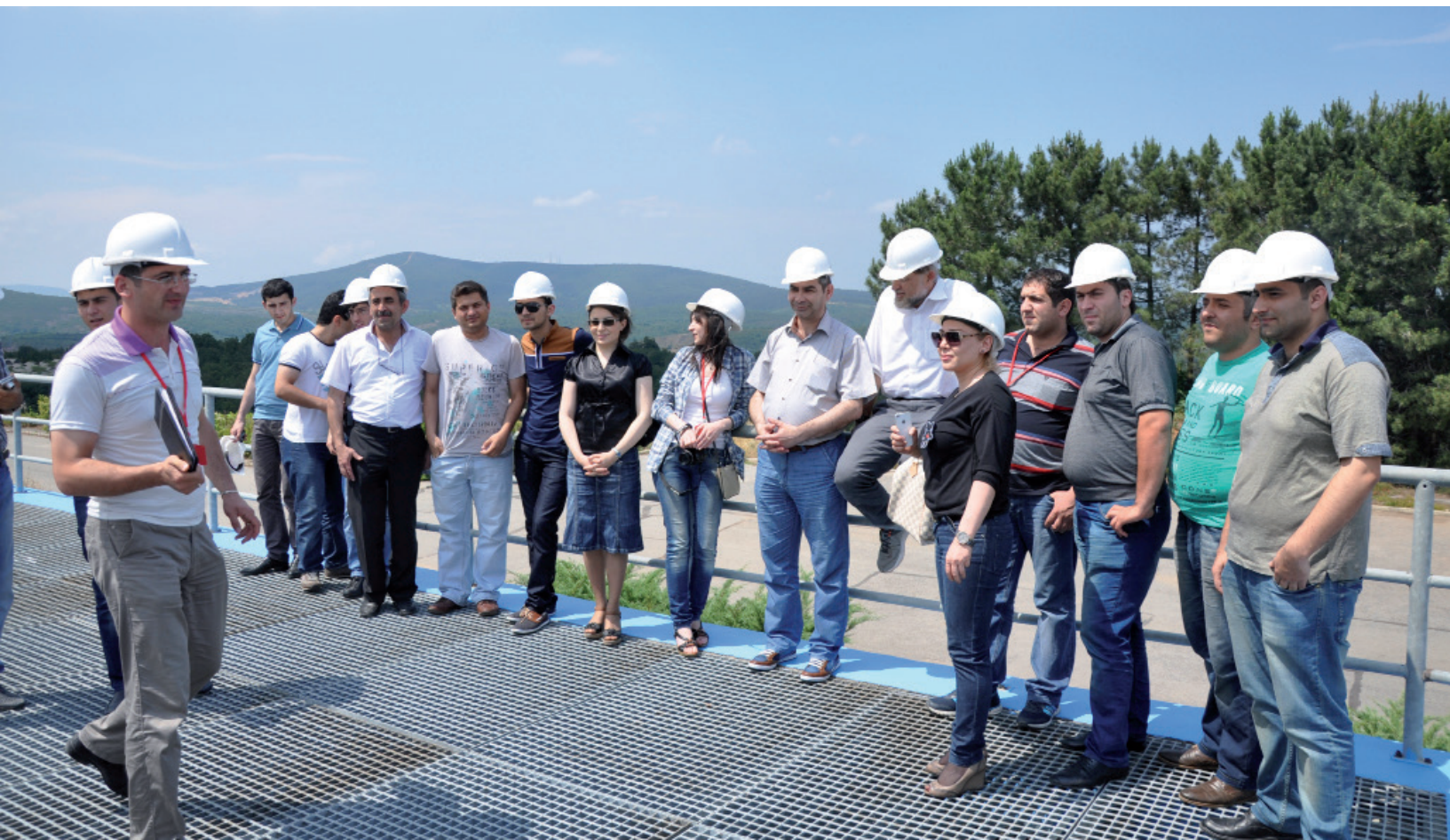

Turkish Water Institute (SUEN) is a national think tank established under the Ministry of Forestry and Water Affairs of Turkey to develop national water policies, provide consultation to decision makers, and enhance scientific research and strategic ideas with a focus on creating a common platform for water management.

SUEN works in cooperation with national and international water-related institutions on issues such as sustainable water management, developing water policies, sustainable energy and capacity building for solving local and global water problems.







## Training Programmes

---

SUEN transfers and shares knowledge in the field of water and wastewater nationally and internationally. Since its establishment in late 2011, SUEN delivered trainings to more than 600 water professionals from over 30 countries.

Training programmes cover the following topics:

- River basin scale planning
- Master planning in the urban water sector
- Water and wastewater treatment design and operation
- Wastewater management in rural areas
- Water and sewage network management
- Groundwater management
- Runoff harvesting

The trainings are delivered by prominent professors with extensive practical experience, who are specialized in the management of water and wastewater.

The programmes in the form of one to three week(s) short courses are specifically tailored to meet each group's needs and include field visits to treatment plants and water administrations. Participants who successfully complete the programmes are awarded with a certificate.

Long term capacity development is designed in three phases as below in line with the T-Shaped Competency Profile.

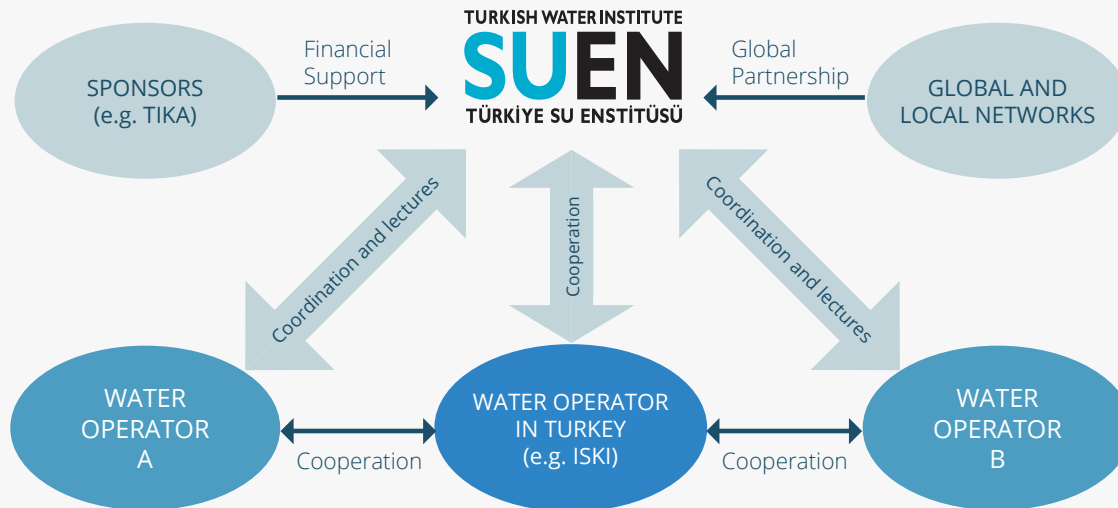






## Networking in the Trainings

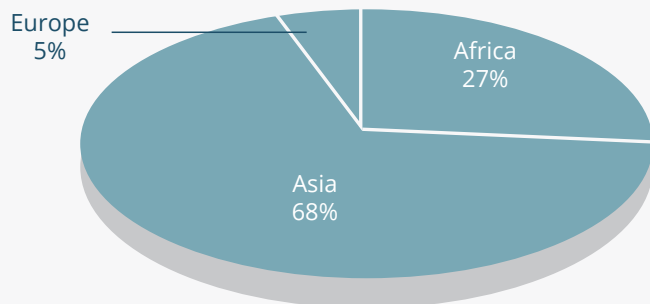
